WE NEED NOMINEES

Qualifications of the Officers:

Central Section Chief

– the Division By-Laws require that you be registered and active in a patrol within the New Hampshire Region. A Section Chief is not permitted to hold any other elective office in the NSP.

The Job:

A Section Chief serves a two (2) year term and is responsible for assisting the RD in coordinating the region's affairs in the central section which consists of Ragged Mt., Franklin Outing Club, Dartmouth Skiway and Storrs Hill Mountain.

Southern Section Chief

– the Division By-Laws require that you be registered and active in a patrol within the New Hampshire Region. A Section Chief is not permitted to hold any other elective office in the NSP.

The Job:

A Section Chief serves a two (2) year term and is responsible for assisting the RD in coordinating the region's affairs in the southern section which consists of McIntyre, Mt. Sunapee, Proctor Academy, Pats Peak and Crotched Mt.

Nomination Deadline

Nominations for the two positions can be made by notifying any member of the Election Committee of your interest in running for one of the positions. Initial notification for interest in running or nominating an individual must be made by **February 01, 2010**, to be on the ballot. Ballots will be distributed to Patrol Director's on or about **February 12, 2010**.

The email addresses for members of the Election Committee are listed at the bottom of this notice.

Election Process

Election ballots for the two positions will be sent to each patrol director. The election will be by secret written ballot and there will be an opportunity for write-in candidates on each ballot. All active members shall be permitted to cast one vote. A **patroller is considered an active member if he/she has a NSP registration number reflecting primary membership in a patrol in the New Hampshire region, excluding alumni, medical associates, candidates and professional division members. Only active members of the patrols located in the southern and central sections will be permitted to vote for the Section Chief position in their respective sections.** Patrollers will have a month to cast their votes. Once all registered active patrollers have voted, the Patrol Director will use the supplied envelope to return the ballots to the Election Committee. ***Ballot return deadline is postmarked by March 12, 2010.***

On or about February 08, 2010 all nominees or individuals indicating an interest in running for one of the two positions will be identified on the New Hampshire Region web site located at www.nhnsp.org. Elections results will be posted on or about March 18, 2010 on the NH Region website
